



Housing For ALL: Third Party Payments

This legislation ensures that no operator of rental housing shall refuse to accept rental payments on behalf of a tenant on the basis that the payment was provided by a person other than the tenant.

What does the Third Party Payments ordinance do?

The Third Party Payments Ordinance requires a Landlord to accept payment of rent from any third party paying on behalf of the tenant.

What forms of rental payments are acceptable?

Rental payments may be made in any format allowed by your lease or written agreement.

Other than the tenant, who or what organizations are able to make rental payments?

Any third party can make the rental payment. This could be a friend, a relative, or a rental assistance agency. If you need assistance with rent, available resources can be found at Rentful.
